

## LawtechUK - Lawtech Sandbox Programmes Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions ("**terms**") govern the terms of your application to and ongoing participation in the programmes you are applying to, known as the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes (the "**Lawtech Sandbox Programmes**").

These terms apply to the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, and you should read them carefully before making your application. Applications to the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes can be made via [www.lawtechuk.io/lawtech-sandbox-programmes](http://www.lawtechuk.io/lawtech-sandbox-programmes) ("**website**"), and you are accepting these terms, and agree to comply with them. SO, PLEASE READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY BEFORE APPLYING TO THE LAWTECH SANDBOX.

There are additional terms on the website and in the application guidance ("**Lawtech Sandbox Programmes Specific Terms**") which will explain the benefits of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, application criteria and how long the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes lasts. You should also ensure that you have read and understood those terms. In the event of conflict between these terms and the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes Specific Terms, the Lawtech Programmes Sandbox Specific Terms will take precedence.

Where we refer to "you" or "your" in these terms, we are referring to the applicant to the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes whether an organisation or individual. Where we refer to 'participant' in these terms, we are referring to any organisation accepted to participate in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.

In these terms references to "our", "we" and "us" means Tech Nation Group Limited. We are the provider of the Lawtech Sandbox, and are a company registered in England under registration number 8843778. Our registered office is at 20-22 Wenlock Road, London, N1 7GU.

These terms will be governed by and interpreted in accordance with English law, and we will both submit any and all disputes arising (including in contract and tort) to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

### **1. Your application**

- 1.1. To apply to become a participant of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, you and your organisation must meet the eligibility criteria at the time of your application, which are explained in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes Specific Terms.
- 1.2. All applications are non-transferable and are subject to the use restrictions set out in these terms.
- 1.3. To submit your application, you need to fill out the application form by clicking the link on the website. The website may direct you to a third party platform which we use to administer applications (e.g. Survey Money Apply). If this is the case, you will be bound by the terms and conditions

and privacy policy of this third party provider. If you experience physical difficulties in completing the application via the website, please let us know and we will be happy to make reasonable adjustments to allow you to apply.

- 1.4. The application form contains certain information which we need in order to assess and review your application, so if you don't provide all of the required information then we will not be able to process your application. Some of the questions we ask will require you to provide aggregated information about your business. To the extent that this information consists of your personal data, by submitting your application to the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes you are agreeing to our use of that data in accordance with these terms and our privacy policy at [https://technation.io/privacy\\_policy/](https://technation.io/privacy_policy/).
- 1.5. By submitting an application to become a participant of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, you confirm that:
  - all information provided by you is true, accurate and complete in all material respects and you will notify us immediately of any material changes to the information submitted;
  - you don't have any actual or potential conflict of interest with us, or any of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes partners, affiliates or sponsors (including with their respective trustees, officers or employees), and if a conflict arises, you must inform us immediately and you acknowledge that we may then withdraw your application from the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes;
  - you will act lawfully, ethically and in good faith and will comply fully with equality and anti-bribery legislation and with other applicable laws, regulations, guidelines and codes of practice, and will comply with our reasonable requirements, including in relation to health and safety and security, while attending events as part of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes; and
  - you are happy for your confidential information and data to be used in accordance with these terms.
- 1.6. Selection for our programmes is entirely at our discretion and we reserve the right to decline your application as necessary, including where our programmes do not match your needs or expectations, we are over subscribed, for any abusive or threatening behaviour, and to maintain compliance with programme responsibilities.

## 2. **What happens after you apply?**

- 2.1. We will assess your application and decide whether or not to accept your application to the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes. Our decisions as to who to accept onto the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes are at all times final. As a general rule we do not provide individual feedback on applications.
- 2.2. We may work with a pool of assessors and advisors when deciding who to shortlist and who to accept onto the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, and so

your information may be passed to them in order to review and evaluate your application.

- 2.3. If you suspect at any time that anyone other than you has obtained access to your user identification code or password, you must notify us as soon as possible.

### **3. How can we withdraw you from the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes or change the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes?**

- 3.1. We do not make any warranty about the accuracy or completeness of the information provided by us about, or provided via, the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.
- 3.2. We may vary, suspend or withdraw the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes at any time; including by changing deadlines, changing the content, times and format of events, meet-ups and workshops or any other part of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.
- 3.3. We may withdraw your application or participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes at any time:
  - 3.3.1. if you breach these terms;
  - 3.3.2. if you fail to participate fully in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes;
  - 3.3.3. in the event of an actual or potential conflict of interest;
  - 3.3.4. if your organisation appoints an administrator or a receiver or goes into liquidation; or
  - 3.3.5. your organisation or any Director in the organisation is found to have been involved in any criminal activity.

### **4. Events and additional services**

- 4.1. As part of your participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes we may from time to time invite you to our events and introduce you to entrepreneurs in residence, coaches, advisors, experts, partners, trainers or regulators (each a “**Network Member**” and together “the **Sandbox Network**”).
- 4.2. Where you are introduced to a Network Member, please note that we do not provide any endorsement or recommendation in relation to services offered by these third parties.
- 4.3. Any decision that you or your business makes to engage with Network Members or other third party for the provision of services is solely a decision for you, and your business to take, and may be subject to separate retainers between you and those individuals or their organisations.

### **5. Your interaction with other participants of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes**

- 5.1. When using any interactive features of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, in particular when making contact with, interacting or corresponding with

other participants or a Network Member, and third parties you shall:

- 5.1.1. not knowingly transmit any data, or send or upload any material that contains viruses, Trojans, worms, spyware, adware, logic bombs or other material that is malicious or technologically harmful;
- 5.1.2. impersonate any person or misrepresent your identity or affiliation with any other person, contain any advertising or promote any services or web links to other sites;
- 5.1.3. not make any contribution which:
  - 5.1.3.1. is defamatory; obscene; offensive, hateful or inflammatory; sexually explicit; promotes violence; promotes discrimination;
  - 5.1.3.2. infringes a third party's intellectual property, breaches any duty of confidence; or
  - 5.1.3.3. promotes any illegal activity; threatens or abuses or invades another's privacy; is likely to harass, upset, embarrass or alarm any other person.
- 5.2. Failure to comply with the above may result in immediate, temporary or permanent withdrawal of your participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.

## **6. How will we use your information?**

- 6.1. We will use the information which you provide to us, including all information in your application form and supporting documentation, contact details for your staff, and details of your business as follows:
  - to administer the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes and to carry out evaluation and research;
  - we may share your information within our organisation, so that we can let you know about our other related programmes, events and activities that may be of interest and opportunity to you;
  - to publish research and evaluation in relation to the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, provided that where we publish information on revenue, funding or number of employees we shall do so on an anonymised and aggregated basis;
  - we may share your contact details and basic information about your business (for example what it does and where you are based) with Network Members. However, we will not share any sensitive commercial information without your consent;
  - on an internal basis only, for any and all other purposes in relation to the furtherance of our business and its objectives.
- 6.2. Your information may be used for the purposes set out in section 6.1

before, during and after the period of your participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.

- 6.3. The security of your information is important to us. We will adopt appropriate technical measures to prevent unauthorised access to that information and to ensure that only those persons that need to see your information will have access to it. We will ask our assessors and Network Members to abide by and implement similar security measures in respect of your information.

## **7. Websites and services we link to**

- 7.1. We may link to other sites and resources provided by third parties via our website or lawtechuk.io and as part of the services we provide, which are provided for information purposes only. Any links should not be interpreted as approval by us of those linked websites or information you obtain from them. We have no control over these sites or resources.

## **8. Confidential information**

- 8.1. You acknowledge that if you provide us with commercially sensitive or confidential information, this information may be used in accordance with these terms. However, you should recognise that the best way to protect your confidential and sensitive information is to only disclose the information necessary for use of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.
- 8.2. All information and discussions within the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes are intended for broadcast within the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes only, and you shall not republish or disseminate any content, videos, offers, features or posts without our consent, unless required to do so by law.

## **9. Publicity and Logos**

- 9.1. We may from time to time require you to provide us with a copy of your business logo ("**your logo**").
- 9.2. We will be entitled to use your logo, together with basic information about your business, including the business name, a brief synopsis of your business, and names of your key officers and senior managers for the purposes of marketing and promoting the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes and in published research and evaluation papers, in both online and offline mediums, including for the promotion of our other work programmes, and future editions/replacements of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.
- 9.3. We may ask you to provide quotations, and participate in video interviews as part of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, and where you are asked to do so you will, as a condition of your participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes be required to participate. In this respect, we will be entitled to use and edit this content for the purposes of internal and external promotion of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes as we see fit.
- 9.4. We may from time to time, whether during your period of participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes, or after its completion, require you to place any of our logos on a prominent section of your website, in order to assist

us in raising awareness of the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes.

**10. Our liability**

- 10.1. We our partners, affiliates and sponsors will not be liable to you, your partners or anyone else in respect of any loss of profit, loss of revenue, loss of business, damage to reputation or goodwill, economic loss, or loss of opportunity (in each case whether direct or indirect), or for any indirect or consequential losses, arising as a result of your application or participation in the Lawtech Sandbox Programmes or as a result of any breach by us of these terms or any reliance by you on any statement made or advice given by us, our assessors, mentors, coaches, partners, contractors or Network Partners.
- 10.2. Without prejudice to section 10.1 above, our maximum liability to you or anyone else under these terms (if any) will be limited to £500. Nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or limit our liability to the extent prohibited by law, including in relation to death or personal injury caused by our negligence or fraudulent misrepresentation.
